

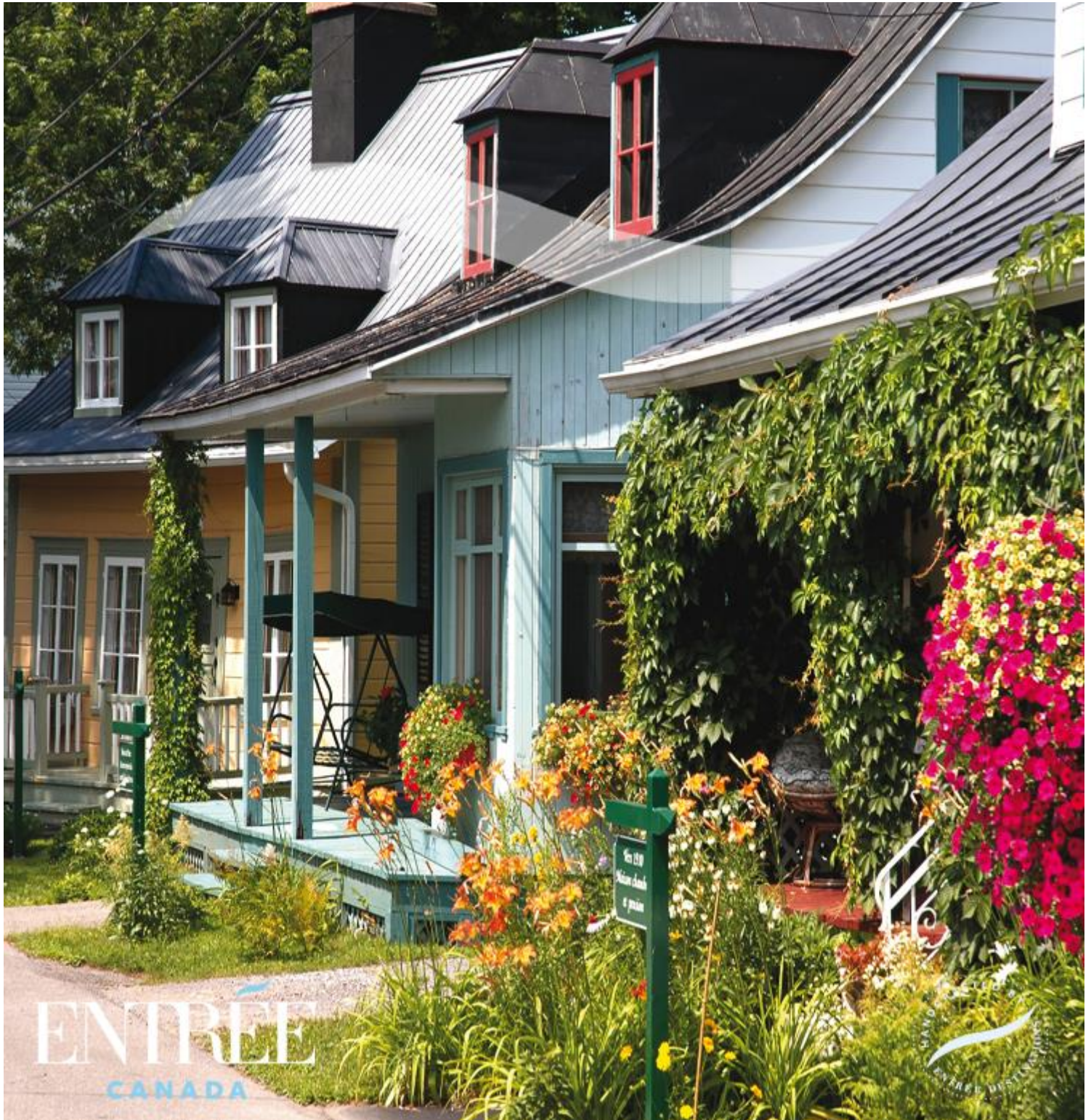

# Tuesday June 23 2020

## Private Quebec City Garden Tour by motorcoach with English-speaking guide (up to 8-hours).

Discover unique Gardens and Landscape sights of Quebec with your knowledgeable English-speaking guide.

Your day will start with a visit to the Domain Cataraqui. This 9.7-hectare (24-acre) estate is one of a handful of historical gardens in the area, in addition to being one of the rare sites to bear witness to the English presence in Québec City during the 19th century. Great artists from Quebec showcase their works here, including Jean-Paul Riopelle, Marcelle Ferron and Marcel Barbeau. The estate comprises a picturesque villa and nine outbuildings, which were completely revitalized in 2010.

Your next stop will be the Bois de Coulonge and its gardens - one of the most remarkable parks in the city. For nearly 20 years, the governors-general of United Canada lived on the property, which was purchased by the Québec government in 1870 and served as the residence of Québec lieutenant-governors until 1966. With its location overlooking the Saint Lawrence River, the beauty of its landscapes as well as its long and prestigious history make Bois-de-Coulonge one of the city's most unique parks.

In the afternoon you will visit the Roger Van den Hende Botanical Garden. The only public garden of its kind in North America, the Roger-Van den Hende Garden showcases nearly 4,000 species and cultivars arranged by botanical family. The City of Quebec botanical garden was founded by the man after whom it is named: Roger-Van den Hende. It was purely a teaching garden in the early years but now it's a public garden with a water garden, a rose garden, an ericacelum, a pergola, a composting site, a herbacelum, an annual evaluation site, tree and Floral screen and modern sculptures. The garden serves as a practical laboratory for students and researchers at Universite Laval and also has a public education vocation.

The tour will conclude back at your hotel.

Stopping at Montmorency Falls, you'll enjoy a panoramic view of the falls and the area. Beautiful Montmorency Falls Park is just a few minutes from downtown Quebec City. The waterfalls are 83-metres (272 feet) tall – a full 30-metres (99 feet) higher than Niagara Falls. Take the cable car up the cliff to start the panoramic walking tour at the Manor, where an interpretation centre, gift shop, and restaurant are housed. Follow the footpath along the top of the cliff to the suspended bridge, which affords a splendid view of the area.

From there, as you follow winding Chemin du Roy—the first road to connect the city to the coast—your guide will tell you more about rural life in the early years of colony. Stop for a visit at L'Atelier Paré, a woodcarving workshop that brings Quebec folk legends to life with storytellers. After an in-depth visit of world-renowned Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupré basilica—the crowning glory of rural Quebec—you'll head to Ile d'Orléans. Afterwards, it's on to l'Auberge La Goéliche, an inn on the south side of the island that offers fabulous views of the city of Quebec, not to mention fabulous food. After a leisurely lunch, depart for La Chocolaterie and watch the artists make chocolates by hand. Finally, you'll make your way back to Quebec City through the village of Sainte Pétronille.

The Parliamentary Food Gardens consist of "in-ground and raised garden beds of edible plants." Some of the city's indigenous plants are grown on the grounds. Crop selection includes blueberries, grape vines and greens.

The next stop will lead you Plains of Abraham and its highlight - Joan of Arc Garden. Created in 1938 by landscape architect Louis Perron, the garden has its own special style: rectangular in shape and built slightly below ground level, it combines the French classical style with the British-style beds. Visitors have





an opportunity to admire over 150 species of annuals, bulbs and, especially, perennials.

The tour will conclude back at your hotel.
